Set among the rolling hills on the banks of Greenock Creek at Seppeltsfield, Hentley Farm founder Keith Henschke went against the grain when selecting three hillside sites to plant Cabernet, and the risk has paid off.

All with an Easterly aspect and minimal topsoil, the vineyard produces bright fruit for this varietal, aromatic and delicately balanced; distinctive of the estate.

VARIETAL CABERNET SAUVIGNON (100%)

PRE-VINTAGE

RAINFALL: Well below average in Winter and Spring. Mild
TEMPERATURE: Mild Spring and early Summer | No extreme heat.
UPSHOT: Low crops, balanced canopies.

VINTAGE

RAINFALL: Well below average in Summer and early Autumn.
TEMPERATURE: Warm throughout.
UPSHOT: Early, compressed vintage | Powerful, vibrant wines.

SEPPELTSFIELD VINEYARD

BLOCKS: Three blocks from the property
VINEYARD: Very shallow red clay loam overlying shattered limestone | North-south oriented rows | Elevated Eastern aspect.
UPSHOT: Reduced natural vine vigour | Intense and vibrant.

WINEMAKING

FERMENTATION: De-stemmed | Seasoned oak | Natural malolactic fermentation | 9 months maturation
CELLARING: DRINK NOW TO 2036

PROFILE: Plum | Cassis | Blackberry | Red earth and dark mineral notes
TEXTURE: Fresh & Vibrant | Great structure & texture.
